



## Student Discipline Training

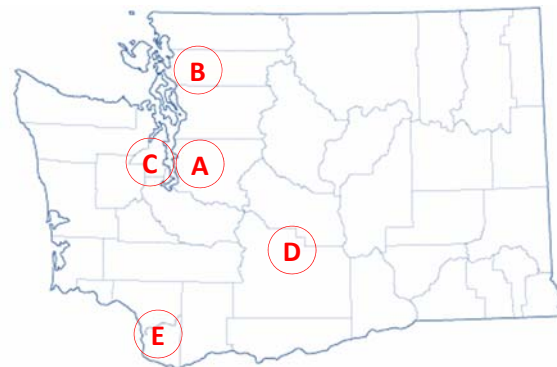
Revised student discipline regulations will become effective in their entirety on July 1, 2019. These new regulations are a marked departure from the student discipline structure that has been in place since 1977, and will require changes in student discipline practices, policies, procedures, and student handbooks prior to the start of the 2019-20 school year.

The attorneys of Porter Foster Rorick have developed professional development and training materials specific to these new student discipline regulations. The trainings cover what all school administrators need to know when administering student discipline, with a focus on the new due process requirements for imposing discipline, the new substantive requirements justifying each form of discipline, and other important concepts introduced or changed by the new regulations.
